What is your child learning next week?

Literacy: we will write a biographical report of Queen Elizabeth II.

Numeracy: we will practise our times tables, weighing and telling the time.

Art: we will study portraits, understand what they are and begin to create portraits of each other.

PE: understand and play games from Victorian times.

PSHE: we will understand how to be respectful of our local culture.

History: we will learn to understand the importance of ceremonial events in our countries history.
