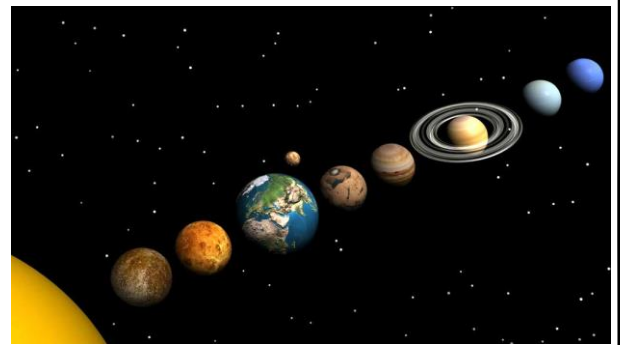

What is your child learning next week?
