What is your child learning next week?

Science: we will continue to learn about animals, their habitats and their food. We will also take part in the RSPB Schools Big Bird Watch. Here is a link to some activities on the RSPB website.

Literacy: we will write our own versions of 'There was an old woman who swallowed a fly'.

Numeracy: We will be looking at estimating a quantity
