Mrs Trout's gardening club.

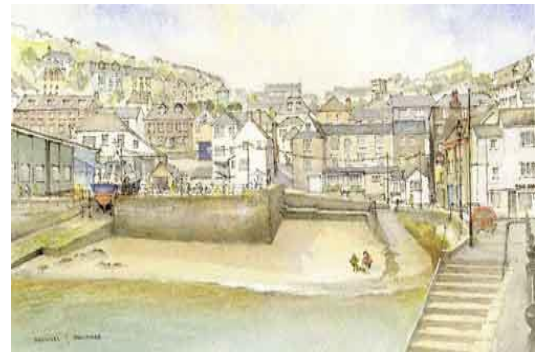
Wednesday:

What is your child learning next week?

English: We will be writing our own African animal poems.

Kiswahili: we will learn to say hello and welcome in Kiswahili one of the language of Kenya.

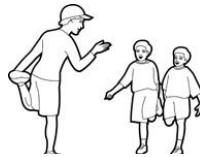


PE KIT
