What is your child learning next week?

Our 4 week topic is 'Art on the doorstep'.

Topic/Science: Experiments linked to the functions of each part of a plant

French: Learn Christmas vocabulary

Literacy: Writing biographies and unaided writing

Maths: Measuring capacity and weight

Music: Listen to pieces of music that have been composed to accompany a piece of art (from last week!)

ICT: Research information using the internet

Art: Creating patterns using clay
