Coming up this week ...

What is being studied next week?

English: Viking poetry

Maths: Times tables, number bonds, addition and subtraction

PE: Netball (working on different pass types with Mrs Burns)

Forest schools session (years 1, 2 and 3 with Mrs Trout on Tuesday and year 4, 5 and 6 with Miss Edwards on Wednesday)

Science: The internal organs of the body
