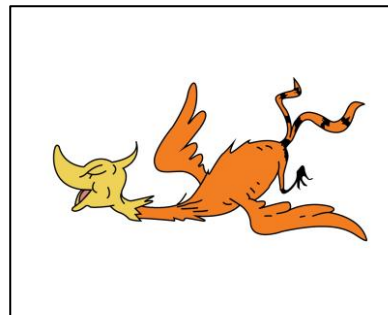
Forest School Newsletter 2
